### Academic Credential Evaluations

Per USCIS regulations, all foreign degrees must be translated and evaluated for U.S. equivalency if/when the foreign national is the beneficiary of an H-1B or E-3 petition. It is also required for an I-140 employment-based petition for permanent residency.

Therefore, an H-1B or E-3 applicant whose highest degree was awarded from an institution outside of the United States (including Canada) is required to submit an official credentials evaluation of their degree(s) from an accredited agency.
